It challenges the conventional idea that focused career exploration and learning should be delayed until late adolescence or early adulthood. Career Guidance doesnt force children to make premature career decisions. It provides them age-appropriate and developmentally relevant career education. Introducing career guidance during childhood helps children think about their interests and abilities in career relevant terms. This can prevent the natural tendency to shape future career aspirations based on limited assumptions and stereotypes rather than childrens unique interests, abilities, personalities, and values. It is well known that children who excel academically are afforded additional learning opportunities, take full advantage of the education provided them, and usually have greater career and occupational options to choose from later in life. However, its also true that dedicated career exploration during childhood enhances academic motivation and leads to better academic performance. Early career education makes academic learning meaningful to children.
